

Graffiti Removers

For use before you apply a graffiti protection coating (to remove current graffiti) and after use once graffiti is applied over the coating.

Coo-Var graffiti removers are available in three forms to best suit your need or preferred method, and all are easy to use:

- **Gel** – slightly mild in its action
- **Liquid** – more tough on graffiti
- **Wipes** – for easy removal of small amounts of graffiti

GP101 Graffiti & Flyposting Protection System

This single pack system is a clear coating which offers long term protection against both graffiti and flyposters.

With this coating being fast drying, it allows you to apply two coats in one day. This means your contractor bill is reduced as well as reducing the chances of a graffiti attack between coats.

With GP101 there is no need to wait until there is enough graffiti to make it worth calling in a contractor to remove it. If a little graffiti occurs it is safe and easy enough to remove it yourself. This can save a lot of money as well as making your property look better because the graffiti is there for less time. Simply clean with water and scrubbing brush or pressure washer.

- Save money by not having to buy solvents
- Save money by washing off graffiti 'in-house'
- Less 'ghosting' remains
- Gloss and matt finishes available
- Fast drying – apply two coats in the same day
- Can be applied to rough or smooth surfaces
- Flyposters do not stick properly and just peel off

Note: Do not clean graffiti off this coating using solvents as this will hinder GP101's performance. Use either water or warm soapy water (e.g. with washing up liquid). Read guidance notes before using GP101 - available from the Coo-Var website.

GP101 Sealer Coat

For porous surfaces, GP101 Sealer Coat is likely to be needed before GP101 Graffiti Protection System is applied.

This is a transparent sealer which will also offer excellent water and mildew resistance on porous surfaces, is acrylic and free of volatile organic solvents. This results in it being low odour, non flammable and low toxicity.

The sealer coat can also be used to further minimise the darkening of sandstone and other natural stone products.

P101 Anti-graffiti Coating

Coo-Var P101 is a two pack, clear aliphatic polyurethane coating which provides a highly graffiti-resistant finish.

This coating has good chemical resistance making it easy to clean and durable. Will not fade or yellow when exposed to high levels of Ultra Violet light, or support the growth of fungus.

This coating dries to a clear, gloss finish and is particularly suitable for outdoor use but can also be used indoors.

P101 is suitable for many surfaces, but is not for use over conventional solvent based paints (ask our Technical Services department if in doubt).



P101 Brushwash/Thinners

Thinners for use with P101 are also available from Coo-Var in 500ml and 5 litre tins.

WB101 Anti-graffiti Coating

Coo-Var WB101 is a two pack, water based, polyurethane coating which acts as a sealer (reducing absorbency), allowing the removal of graffiti with solvent based products (see Graffiti Removers section) and easy cleaning for hygiene reasons.

Being water based, this coating is low odour. This is usually important within indoor environments such as hospitals, schools and other public buildings.

Dries to a clear, off-gloss finish.
